Response from the college:

The college has constituted Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as per the NAAC guidelines, and the date of establishment of IQAC mentioned in the Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) format is 31/5/2022.

Since the establishment of IQAC, it has prepared the work of submission of IIQA, preparation and submission of SSR, preparation for Qualitative metrics writing for 500 words for each metric, preparation and filling the data in the prescribed templates of quantitative metrics, a compilation of DVV work as per the DVV partners suggestions and preparation work for peer team visit.

The Government of Maharashtra introduced the Maharashtra Public Universities Act in 2016, as per the said Act section 117; affiliating university appoints an expert committee to conduct an Academic and Administrative Audit of the college.

About Academic and Administrative Audit:

The overall observations of the AAA committee based on the inputs collected from IQAC and various departments and interactions with the stakeholders are:

1. Criteria I: Curriculum Aspects:

The college has affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University. The affiliating university has revised the curricula of all the programs periodically. The college offers B. A. & B. Com. programs. The cross-cutting issues are incorporated into the curricula by the affiliating university. The college collects feedback on the curriculum from the students, teachers, alumni, and employers.

Strength:

- a) The college has good infrastructure.
- b) The college admits students belonging to SC, ST, OBC & economically weaker sections students.
- c) Weaknesses:
 - a) The college has limited research work.
 - b) The college has limited MoUs & collaborative linkages.

2. Criteria II: Teaching Learning and Evaluation:

The college is committed to provide quality education as well as human excellence. The academic audit confirms that quality is inseparable from teaching and learning. Teaching and learning are the main focus of the educational process. The subject teachers identify the advanced and slow learners & conduct remedial coaching and special classes for students to perform better in the examinations.

Admission is based on merit and reservation policy laid down by the Government of Maharashtra and an affiliating university. The college organizes internal examinations before the final examination for the evaluation process.

Strength

- a) ICT-enabled, participatory, and interactive teaching-learning methods are promoted.
- b) Internet connection is provided to the students free of cost.
- c) The curricular and the co-curricular activities are balanced in the Teaching Learning process to provide holistic education to the students.
- d) The Admission committee is vigilant in making the admission process transparent and efficient.
- e) IQAC also conducts feedback on the curricula.

Weakness:

- a) The rural background of the students who have had initial education in a vernacular language requires lots of effort to bring them up to a threshold level.

3. Criteria III: Research, Consultancy, and Extension:

The college has constituted a research committee that guides and encourages the teachers to take up research grants from the funding agencies. The college has approved the NSS unit and, through the unit, organizes several extension and outreach activities in the vicinity of the college

Strength

Weakness

- a) The college has fewer research publications.

4. Criteria IV: Infrastructure and Learning Resources:

The college has state-of-the-art infrastructure & is sufficient to conduct the teaching-learning process. The library is equipped with books, journals, newspapers, and computers to deal with the demands of the student and teachers.

Strength.

- a) The college has a huge playground.
b) The college has a legacy of organizing various sports events, an indoor stadium and a modern gymnasium.

Weakness.

- a) The library has partially automated.

5. Criteria V: Student Support and Progression:

The college is committed to the well-being and safety of the students. The college assists the students wherever possible to ensure their learning experience is pleasant, healthy, and proactive. The students are given information on admission, financial aid, rules, and regulations through the college website, prospectus, and notice board. The students from economically weaker sections are given access, and the reservation policy of SC/ST/Minority students is strictly followed. Grievance Redressal Cell / Internal Complaint Cell, Career Guidance Cell, Placement Cell, Anti-Ragging Cell, and Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell are there and support to the students. Financial support is given to the students through scholarships. Annual sports day is conducted to promote sports and games.

Strengths

- a) Notable performance of the students in academic, sports, and cultural activities.
b) Students participate in various committees constituted by the college.

Weaknesses:

- a) The college has not constituted a Student Council.

6. Criteria VI: Governance, Leadership, and Management:

The college has pro-active & proactive management & follows participatory management in its day-to-day work.

- a) The college location belongs to a less rainfall area.


